- a. IP – Thanks to Swado for bringing the Fusion Cruiser to Dayboro. IS – My pleasure.
- b. IP - CAVFA meeting was basically a waste of time not much come out of it.
- c. GP – Haven't heard anything back from Murphy's creek so they must be happy with the G-wagon.



3.2. Operations Manager Report

a. Statements

AR tabled the Operations Manager Report for July 2022 and provided an overview.

b. Business Arising from Operations Manager Report

- a. GP – why are we looking at dialling from home? AR – we are having such a struggle getting enough staff. This would hopefully open us up to more staff being able to hire people from the Sunshine Coast or Hervey Bay etc and also give flexibility to dialling times etc. Currently we are on a slow decline of staff, and we need to look into other options. IP – What about another office in like Caloundra or something like that? AR – That could potentially be a possibility once we move to the cloud. JC – also if we went to those areas, we would probably looking at paying an extra \$8-\$10 an hour to compete with call centres down there. IS – what the implications from WHS? AR – I am looking into all of this at the moment but there are all minimum requirements that need to be followed. JC – we should have 20 people in the call centre daily and we are getting around 9-10. GP – what are they paid currently? AR - Currently an agent starts on \$28.34 per hour plus commissions. GP – should we raise the income by 10% to get more staff? AR – I don't think that is going to make a difference. When we advertise on seek now you have to pick a payrate category and ours says from \$25 to \$35 and it doesn't get more people applying. IP – do we pay them per call, so they aren't sitting at home doing nothing? AR – we monitor all the staff now to make sure they aren't sitting there doing nothing and it would be the same for the staff working from home, the supervisors monitor this from their screen.
- b. AR - There is no budgeted figure as the budget has not been approved yet, this will be the same for next month.
- c. IS – What was the complaint? AR – It was a customer complaint against an agent for being rude.
- d. IS – do we need to sell a certain number of tickets per prize? AR – We have to supply 20% of rrp for the total art union. E.g. if it's an \$600,000 art union, we have to provide \$120,000rrp in prizes. It doesn't go off the number of tickets sold. IP – should we be ordering 12months in advance for the cars? AR – we are ordering 2 or 3 art unions ahead to try and make sure the prizes are here on time, but they just cannot guarantee when the cars are going to arrive unfortunately. If we can't supply the car within a month of the draw we have to give the customer an option of another prize but its impossible to get anything at the moment. IP – laptops are good prizes to do. AR – they are, there just isn't much discount given on them unfortunately. We still do them when we can. We are just working closely with Madill's and Harvey Norman to get the best prize availability.

3.3. General Manager Report

b. Business Arising from General Manager Report

- a. JC – We had a meeting with Adam Stevenson in relation to the Bushfire Heavy Attack and at the end of that meeting he wanted to talk about potential structures. The week after we had a pre meeting with the Commissioner and John Oliver from the UFU as Ian was going to be away and they were wanting to find out our position on structure. We told them our position was the same structure that was voted on by the state executive in 2020. The UFU have a position, but they won't tell anyone what it is. What we are hearing is everything is still on track to be announced next month. It is now with treasury to see if there is enough money for police to pick up VMR, Coast Guard & SES. QFES are not happy about this. July/June next year is looking like when the changeover will be completed.
- b. JC – Guardian - we have written to the new Senator to get it going again.
- c. JC – Stewart & Heaton want to provide 500 trauma teddies with our logo on it. They are going to donate \$4,000 to us which we can provide a receipt for then we will purchase the bears with those funds. IP – Area Office already have those bears. JC – but they aren't on the trucks.
- d. JC – AFAC is in Brisbane next year, we will have the Bushfire Heavy there. We will try and get the RFBAQ stand as close to that Bushfire Heavy as possible. We will have a proper RFBAQ stand that is manned by staff. We will get a deal for volunteers to get free entry and make it where they come to us for their lunch packs etc.
- e. JC – Celfi go's have been posted and waiting on TJ to organise the fitting. IP – he is pushing for free NBN on stations.
- f. JC – At Parliamentary Friends of Rural Fire Brigades function, there was going to be an announcement that the Fire Service were going to give a reconditioned Nissan Patrol to the Camp Gregory Veterans. This will still be going ahead and should happen just before Christmas. Will keep you posted on this Dave as they are in your RFBAQ Area

4. GRANT APPLICATION

4.1. GN22/640 – Aratula Rural Fire Brigade - \$6,451 – Fit Out New 81 Unit

- a. JC – only previous grants was a hardship grant. 30 active members. Originally, they applied for \$9,271 but \$2,820 was for decaling the vehicle so I rang and spoke to Alan Gillespie, their Regional Manager, and he said he will pay for that so that brought it down to a total of \$6,451. IP – can't have a siren on it. JC – it was signed off by the Area Director. GP – how much was the siren? JC – it's not itemised. IS – how much has the brigade put into the vehicle? JC - \$7500. IS – My belief is no brigade sure be given a total amount from us, I believe a brigade should always be putting in towards the vehicle. IP – there is never a definite need for an 81.
All members happy to approve grant.

4.2. GN22/641 – Boyne Valley Rural Fire Brigade - \$5,926.90 – Electric Motors for Roller Doors & Power Socket

- a. JC – Gave background on Brigade & want they are wanting. Previous grant they have had was a FLIR camera and that's it. They have a lease on the station with another lease for 30 years



that's just been approved. GRC doesn't collect a fire levy rather GRC supports brigades out of General Rates. **All members happy to support**

4.3. GN22/642 – Veteran Rural Fire Brigade - \$4,488 – Replace Existing Air-Conditioner

- a. JC – Previous grant was from 2010 for an air-conditioner which died so they are wanting to replace it. They are the staging area for the floods here and are a very active brigade. They are wanting one for training room and kitchen. IP – how much money do they have? \$20,000 in the bank. GP – do they have any projects in the works? JC – I don't know. They are an extremely active Brigade. **All members happy to support**

4.4. JS – Suggestion from Pat Noye regarding wording on the Grant Application

- a. JS – Pat suggested we change the wording on the grant application forms to read shed construction/improvements. IP happy to do that.

5. GENERAL BUSINESS

5.1. JC – 5000 Lt Skid (Slip-on)

- a. JC – Got a good price with a good design of a 5000lt skid to go out on the back of a flatbed truck and trailer. We will go see the brigades out in the central west and far west and see if it what they need/like. Would be around February as that is when Cam said it's the best time. Take Sally Gall (journalist) with us. We would get the feedback on it and see if there is appetite for it and if there is a need for it, we would try and get it available on stores. We have spoken about this in previous meetings so if you like it, we could go ahead and buy one and take it around. It was \$13,210 in total. JC – are you happy to go ahead and order one to take around and then go to the Fire Service in February and get it added to stores if there is a need for it? **All members happy to go ahead.** JC – when we see the Commissioner, we will tell him we need a flatbed truck with a trailer and a driver. We have flagged it with the fire service already.

Motion: Go ahead and order 5000lt Skid to take around.

5.2. JC – Yellow Ribbon Day & Parliamentary Friends of Rural Fire Brigades

- a. JC – As you know this was cancelled due to the passing of the Queen. we will do it again next year. It was very popular, we had 127 people who were going to attend. DM – do we have a date for it next year? JC – no we should know around February; we need to wait to find out the sitting date for next year.



5.3. JC – Bushfire Heavy Attacks

- a. JC – There is an Isuzu cab chassis and by Thursday we will have an answer. Should be done by the 23rd of March 2023. It will be ready to go for Summit. The Bushfire Heavy and Fusion Cruiser will be there side by side. It will then go out to Farm fest, LQAQ etc. IP – what about the Victorian one? JC – it is my understanding it will still go around as well at the same time. JC – Ours is more simplified but will have all the safety aspects we built into the Fusion Cruiser. We will have feedback forms on this as well.

5.4. JC – Fusion Cruiser

- a. GP – I have got a plan starting on the 24th of sept at Nanango. Dave black has organised 2 viewings then off to Dave. Will stay at Gin Gin. DM – I already have one viewing setup and another should be organised shortly. GP – Then to Rocky to Mackay, haven't been able to get in contact with the Mackay rep. Then will go to Ayr then to Charters towers. NB – what date is this. GP – 30th. Then I'm off to OSWG for a few days then I will head to Atherton then to Tinaroo which Les has organised a display. Then head to Townsville for the General Meeting then I will fly home from Townsville and the vehicle will stay there for the week then Justin will pick it up and head up to LGAQ. Ian will be driving it back to Rocky which I will meet him there and pick it back up again on the 21st of October.

5.5. IS – QFES Complaints Process

- a. IS – I attended a complaint's hearing interview. The second officer put in a complaint against another member which the member put in a cross complaint against the second officer. It all got messy because the chairman gave the member a copy of the complaint made against him by the second officer, but the second officer didn't know anything about the cross complaint made against him. My objection to the process is that people go into these meetings without any background information or knowledge as to what its for. I can't believe the Fire Service can basically force a member to go into a complaint's hearing without any former knowledge before they walk into the room. I would like to have it taken up with the Commissioner but would like to hear your views. IP – I think the problem is it goes through the regional staff, and they have no idea on how to handle complaints. IS – They do have a process and the person doing it at the time was very fair and reasonable. I did raise my concerns before the meeting started. I was considering advising the 2 people not to attend until they get information beforehand. It's the process; it's totally unfair. GP – Is it supposed to be a mediation type session? DM – if a decision is being made all parties need to be aware of what is happening. IS – There was no decision being made it was a discovery, but one party had all the information and the other did not. QFES is following Public Service Guidelines. I can't accept this is allowed.

Resolution: RFBAQ to write a letter to the Commissioner stating our concerns and that the process be rectified so people don't go into an interview without the background information.

Carried: 13/09/2022

IP - We can take that to him on Thursday. JC – problem is you get people who don't know what they are doing so they make it up. Hopefully in the future we will have people that know what they are doing. JC – Change is coming. People will be hired for a job not given a rank then assigned a job. IP – We will talk to him on Thursday and let him know there is a letter to follow.



5.6. IS – Information to All Volunteers on How to Terminate a Member Correctly According to The Brigade Manual Directives

- a. IS – District offices having been sending out notices of termination to members regarding BlueCard, but as you know QFES can't terminate a member. I would like Information to be provided to all volunteers regarding the proper process on member termination, so they are not railroaded. IP – The process is in the manual. IS – I know but I would like it disseminated to all committee members, so they are aware of the proper procedure. JC – TJ called and asking why we want it recalled and we told him because its not right. JC – It was recalled. That comes down to no leadership. IS – I would like the information on our website and sent out in a Fireline and put on Facebook. JC – even if we did that, we would probably reach 10-15% brigades. The best answer is when the change happens, we reengage then with the board and the working strategic groups. Etc, it needs to come from the Fire Service not us otherwise they don't believe it. Big change is coming. GP – ATSO are way off the money with procedures anyway. One said when we give away Landcruisers they then don't get given a replacement at the end of its life. JC – That's not true, did you tell him he was wrong? GP – Yes. IS – this is the trouble they are all new or acting. IP – There is no training program for them. DM – I don't know if the change is going to fix all of that. IS – I have pulled Mark Saunders up a number of times if he is wrong. DM – maybe we put on our website common misinformation.

Nellie left at 11.30am

IS – how are we going to go about it? IP- advise people termination is by the manual. IS – but they can't terminate. JC – QFES love sacking people. Answer was not to do BlueCard, but no one is game to do it. When we get the Fireboard, we will be able to go to the government and change the process but still meet the same objective. JC – I think we wait for the change and reengage then and do it properly. IS – it can't wait. IP – you said the board, but we don't manage the board. JC – why would we manage the board. IP – you could end up with a majority on that board who are lovers of QFES. It could not work out. JC – there won't be a QFES though. DM – it could still be stacked. JC – the Minister wants a happy Rural Fire's Board; they aren't going to stack it. There will be no QFES. IP – we don't know the full extent of how they are going to choose the board. JC – We just have to wait & see. IS – we just have to keep pushing for good staff. JC – It's just like you're not happy with anything. JC – if we wrote out saying you can't do this in relation to BlueCard we would be back to where we were in 2019.

Resolution: Ask the Commissioner to produce the correct termination process using an easy-to-read Flow Chart and send it out and we will share it as well.

Carried: 13/09/2022

JC – if the change happens, it will happen around our election process and there are talks of more area offices. They are talking openly about the change in Kedron with things starting in February. IP – I don't think you will see any boundary changes for 6-12 months.

5.7. IP - \$500,000 Fire Danger Rating Sign

IP - I want this on the agenda for the General Meeting. JS – it's already on the agenda. IP – we have been treated with disrespect over this whole thing. IS – the Minister was happy with us to go with it, so how is he going to feel about us pulling it out. JC – he will be disappointed, but he



will understand. We have tried over and over again to make this happen, but QFES don't want to work together. IS – we need to inform the minister. JC – he is well aware.

5.8. GP – Repair Kit

- a. GP - I got asked whether the department can make a hose repair kit for high pressure hoses. If you break a hose on the fire ground, you then can't utilise the pump system. Suggested we have a Field Service Repair Kit like you do for Hydraulic Hoses. If everyone is in favour, we could mention this at OSWG? IP – I think Saunders was looking into this. JC – yea mention it at OSWG.

5.9. JC – Trust Fund

- a. JC – What's happening with the trust? IP – we don't have one. JC – you do because there is money in it. IP – we need to reappoint members. JC – Where is the heavy? IP – on a boat. JC – we have been hearing that for ages. It will be interesting to see if they ever finish it. IP – They have to, it's been signed off.

Operations Manager Report – September Management Committee Meeting

Riverside Hotel – Southbank Brisbane

- Had weekly meetings with Senior Supervisor.
- Always trying to reduce costs where possible and bringing overhead down (ongoing).
- Continuously submitting requests for additional Art Union tickets to the Office of Liquor and Gaming.
- We have replaced all the office chairs. The new chairs are very popular and staff are most grateful for comfortable seats.
- I attended the Telstra Vantage conference in Sydney. I attended lots of informative sessions about moving forward in the digital world.
- Gympie ANZ has now finally reopened.
- We are experiencing a payment processing issue which is being investigated by several different suppliers. No-one seems to be able to rectify the issue. We are currently waiting for our payment provider EziDebit to come back to us with some results of testing they are undertaking.
- We have installed a Zip Tap in the kitchen which supplies constant boiling water and also chilled water. This eliminates the need to have urns and kettles and also will save money as we can cancel our water delivery.
- We are currently working with PowerConnex and Efex to implement Agents being able to dial from home. This is proving to be a reasonably big task but should be very popular once it is ready to go. We need to look into HR and WHS requirements for this.
- We have had to have some disciplinary meetings with a staff member, due to customer complaints. There has also been some tension between 2 staff members which we are constantly monitoring and addressing as required.
- Ongoing training amongst the office staff is consistently happening to ensure there is plenty of coverage for absences and leave.
- We are having major issues trying to source prizes and the cost of prizes (mainly vehicles) is soaring. Unfortunately, our hands are tied with this and our suppliers are looking after us as best they can given the circumstances.
- I have been helping Jess with the Parliamentary Friends of Rural Fire event.
- The sample cooler bag for summits arrived at the office and looks great and feels like a really good quality cooler bag. I think they will be very popular with the volunteers at the summits.
- We now have a Defib onsite at the office and all the admin and supervisor staff have watched the video on how to use it properly.
- We have now finalised the printer change over. The previous company Our Kloud were impossible to deal with. We have now got the new printer from our IT provider Efex, it is good to keep as much with the same supplier as possible. The printer is a superior printer as well for a cheaper monthly cost.
- Completed the second round of requirements from the accountant.
- The office has updated our fire warden training & We are currently looking into First Aid qualified staff onsite and will look at updating this if required.
- I am working on the budget.
