6. Joanne Greenfield & Alan Gillespie - Changes to QFES

- 6.1.** IP – Where do we stand on the EOI? Are we a part of it or do we have to apply for it? JG – there's lots of ways where the RFBAQ can engage. The Commissioner will be going a road show, which we can share the engagement calendar with you. Your reps can apply for the Reference Groups if they want too. The Commissioner came up to your meeting in December and will be here again today. There so many points of engagement and there will be specific times we come and talk to you just like today. IP – will the reference group met in Kedron? JG - it will be a mix of teleconference and face to face. IP – the reference group, what will be their roll? JG – explained how the reference group will work. IP – so we won't have a presence without applying for it? JG – That's correct. IP – what is the roll of the reference group? JG – There is a implantation task force led by Steve Gollschewski, which I believe you have had contact with. IP – all's that come through was him asking for a contact person. JG – yea so when he starts engaging, he will come back to that person. The Commissioner has the mandate to set



up the new service. The reference group will be advising the Commissioner. IS – will there be a regularly monthly meetings? JG – no specified time yet, it will be between February and March for engagement where we will take all the feedback and then he plans to come back in June. He will take on what he hears first time around and listen and then go back out again. On top of that we have Alan's new team as well. GP – which is? AG – we don't know who will be on it yet. IP – is that staff? AG – yea they are all staff. JG – what Alan and I are doing is about RFS and what the Commissioner is doing is about the whole department. Even though we will be independent we still need to plug into the department for support such as fleet support, we need the media team etc. IP – independent was taken out of context, we want to be independent on the fire ground to the urbans. IP – we had a situation the other day with the urbans disrespecting us. JG – 14th February we will have an AC that's come from RFS. So to answer your question there are a lot of points where the RFBAQ can engage. There is lots of points where the reps can engage at the sessions, we can come and have meetings with you. IP – if a RFBAQ rep applies will we be considered? AG – absolutely, they would be considered just like anybody else. They have a lot of experience why wouldn't we. JG – we want to hear the voices from the different places. IS – we had a lot of push back at a meeting about the reference groups because volunteers feel like its all about the staff. The staff will be remunerated to attend but the volunteers have to go on their own resources. JG – if a volunteer goes to them, we will definitely support them. It was basically saying no one will be paid overtime to do this. GP – would someone like me be listened to or will it all be the new people who don't know what they are doing? AG – we want to hear from the old, the new, the Western, the Northern, the southern, the RFBAQ reps. We want to hear from everyone. This is about getting the best outcome for our volunteers and community. I am happy to come talk to you in a formal or informal meeting. I will engage directly with the reps. Anything I organise I will let Justin know and all the reps. The feedback we are getting so far, there is nothing surprising. At the moment we are gathering information, we will then go back and analyse the information, then we will go back out again and say this is how we think RFS should look and get feedback on that and then discuss it again. There are some must haves and there are some non-negotiables on this and I have got to say they are all in favour of RFS. We will have our own chief officer; we are going to have our own AC's. We will no longer be reporting to a QFES AC. We will have our own command structure. IS – we submitted a draft structure, so how far will it deviate from ours? AG – If you are talking about the KPMG review structure, I think its not going to be too far out of that. You need to recognise RFBAQ are not the only stakeholders here. We have to consult with a whole range of people and get their views on what the structure should look like. We have only just started the consultation. IS – so you have nothing planned so far? JG – there is nothing below regions yet. AG – the Ministers view is very clear and that is it has to be front lined focused (small head, big bum). The whole concept is to do whatever it takes to allow the Inspectors and BTSO's to be out there engaging with their brigades and stakeholders. GP – when are you going to stop locking the area offices? Anyone use to be able to go in there and now we can't. There is no service whatsoever. AG – that is one of the things being raised loud and clear. We are wanting their office in the future will be in their car. GP – so you are going to stop tying them up in meetings so they can? AG – absolutely, we want them out there talking to volunteers. We are asking them what they are currently doing and keeping them from getting out there so we can figure out how to best fix this issue. Any changes need 7 different signatures which will be changing. IS – I can see there is a lot of work to be done. AG – there is nothing in this for me, at the end of this I am retiring. My legacy will be building the best RFS than ever before. This has to benefit volunteers at the front line. GP - who is Alan Gillespie? AG – my position is chief superintendent RFS reform taskforce. JG – Peter Hollier is going to be the AC. JG – I understand there is scepticism of this process and where it is going. IS – its more concern. JG – I hope we get the fleet better, better training etc. AG – in my new world it will be very easy. GP – Gave example of situation that happened in his area recently. If the area directors come to the meetings, they should be filling in the paperwork. IP - there are no certificates. AG – in my mind it will all be kept local. JG – With the Dean Cording case, since then we have changed things. It doesn't change the powers it changes the charges



laid. We are trying to make changes in the legislation, but it is a very long process, but we are pushing really hard. IP – we haven't got real legislated powers. JG – once we get to that part, we definitely need RFBAQ's voice in that. IP – regions, where will they be? AG – that is yet to be determined. IP – how can we comment if we don't know what you are looking at. AG – we don't know until we do the consultation. IP – will there be a regional manager, inspector etc AG – we are not just changing the staff we have around now. There will be state, regions, next level down name yet to be determined (business hub) then the areas. So, we want it for the work to be done at areas or business hub. IP – the area offices are so spaced out. AG - it's clear we need more area offices. IP – at least 10 more. JG – where do you think they should be? IP – Burnett for sure. JG – we have to work out where we prioritise them. AG – they are going to look different because we want the staff out and about. They should be mobile area offices; they need to be out and about talking to the volunteers. More area offices is the Minister's requirement. It is all about doing service on the ground. JG – these are the conversation we need to be having while we are out. IS – the thing that concerns me is the SOU will try get control over the top of the RFS. JG – you are right. AG – until we talk to everyone, we can't say what its going to look like. IP – to take the pressure of brigades we need to look at our own workshops for repairs. AG – I disagree with that; it's not cost effective. IP – you don't see the costings. AG – I absolutely do see the costings, I have to approve them. IP – I am talking about the cost on my first officer. AG – why isn't the area office dealing with it? IP – I rung our area office and AD was on leave and was basically told to go away get a quote and we will pay for it. It is doing first officers heads in. AG – in my region, it is all done by the staff it's not dealt with by the volunteers. All you should do is say my truck is broken and we should bring a replacement. GP – driver training should be offered. IS – I have asked about 4wd training, and it's just not being considered. I have been pushing this for 30 years but said no because it's too expensive. AG – I absolutely acknowledge we don't do training properly. IS – it all comes down to mindset issue. JG – I have a clear mindset. GP – training. There needs to be a simpler process on training.

11.10am Commissioner & Chief of staff arrived.

7. Commissioner Greg Leach

GL – We are busy dealing with a possible deployment to Norfolk Island for the tropical cycle. IP – I heard Australia is sending a team to Syria? GL – yes NSW is sending a team of 72 people if we go to a second rotation which it might that will fall to our team. We have a lot happening at the moment. IS – if we don't get rain in our area soon, it's going to be a really bad fire service. GL – Independent review process has been a 3-year journey so far. You've all seen the KPMG review. Government made a decisions late November to change it. There were 19 recommendations and the one they didn't accept was emergency levy to collect money for the SES. 18 out of the 19 were accepted. GL – they want us to implement the intent from the KPMG report. Establish the Qld Fire Department as a dedicated Fire Services Department consisting of the Fire & Rescue Service & the Rural Fire Service. Establish the role of Chief Fire Officer as a statutory position responsible for assurance, culture, integration, research and best practice. It must be held by a qualified and professional Fire Officer. They want a clear chain of command for incident response recognising the expertise of both agencies. GP – are we still going to be lumbered with the catch cry of "we are the paid professional and you're just a volunteer"? GL – we need create in the new organisation a mutual respect. My view is we are all professional. IP – the biggest issue will be firecom. GP – we need to get that right. IP – we had a case the other day where the red truck shouldn't have been there. IS – we need people who are aware of the area, so they respond the right brigade to the right area. IP – we need to fix firecom. They just send red trucks when they are not needed. GL – They can only dispatch resources based of what they are told from the caller. Part of it, we need to look at a structured call process. IS – they will have to rewrite the computer program which took 5 years last time. JG – We will still have our own Cafs system, but we need to be interoperable across all services. IS – That goes



without saying. GL – Government have also established that the RFS will be a separate entity within the department with its own dedicated budget and advisory board. The Minister was very clear about this. GP – advisory board made up of who? GL – we haven't got that far yet, that's all to be worked out. State emergency services, surf lifesaving, SES etc will be moving over to police. Steve's workload went from just us to being quite significant. He has had to expand his team to handle it. Shane will be helping him with the reform so he will be working closely with us as well. There are 2 key things we know at the moment. The 142 million uplift money will start to flow from July 2023. Second thing we know is Steve and his team need to be wrapped up by 30th June 2024. The Minister wants all these reforms in place and done and dusted before the election. The other thing happening in March next year, we have local government elections. In a meeting the other day they are thinking there will be a 30 - 40 percent turnover in mayors in the next election. A lot of mayors decided to stay on in COIVD to help their communities. On top of that we have a severe weather season happening. The SES have a lot on at the moment as well. The Minister has said the RFS will determine what the RFS looks like. The Minister is saying it should look like a small head with a big bum, meaning more people out on the ground supporting volunteers. IS – they need to give the volunteers what they want and let them do their job. GL – What does a better service look like? It will be good quality appliance, good quality equipment, good training, good command and control etc. GP – the main thing the department is there for is to support the volunteers, but volunteers won't go to area office because it's so difficult to get in there. ATSO and BTSO are spending more time doing paperwork, meetings etc. GL – we want that ATSO and BTSO out there. We want more people behind the scenes doing the paperwork, so they are out there. AG – in the new world it will work a lot better. IP – the way uniform orders are done is not working. GL – looking at new systems for ordering etc to make it easier. IS – the training program we have is not what we need as there was no consultation with it. JG - There is a lot we need to look at with the engagement process. IP – Communication is hard out on the fire ground. GL – some of those things are out of our control. Telstra are looking at new systems so no matter where you are you will get satellite. JG – we will be talking to NBN as well. GL – Coming back to training, it is a huge issue for us, and we do need to look into this. GP – I have spent plenty of time training and now with the new packages it's not acknowledged. GL – we need to get good legislation right. We need to make sure we build the right legislation for the Fire Service we make. Government haven't set a timetable for this, but we see it as 3 different engagement processes. First one February to March to get the initial consultation. Then we will come back and collate all of that and come back in June or July then toward the end of the year come back and say what we think it should look like. GP – One thing I would like to see is some education or information for new land holders and it shouldn't be on the volunteers to educate property owners either. IS – it's not just new land holders. GL – we need to do community education. GP – now that there are fire levies, property owners now have the expectation on the brigades for fire prevention. GL – what does the right number of areas look like? IP – need another 10 at least. Burnett for sure. Maryborough, Gympie. GL – we would need to work out the requirement for an area office and a satellite office. AG – they want more area directors out there. An area office might not be an actual office. AG – work out of a current fire stations. IP – could easily stick a shipping container near fire stations. AG – we were told we all need to get on the same path, but we are changing because we are listening to what has been said. GL – we are not sitting on a grand plan; we are building this as we go. AG – the delegation will be down to that business hub. JG – we need to be clear on what state does. IS – is there a program for consultation? GL – yes, we do but it's changing constantly. AG – we are using workshops and field days that are already happening so we can see more people. I will be talking to the regional managers about the process we want to use. I want to see it duplicated how Townsville do it. They are so well organised. AR – they are so well organised and do such a good job up there. NB – concerned about medal presentations, the people getting these medals are all paid staff. We have quite a few members who have done this for 40 to 50 years and have received nothing. Have a look and see if this can't be rectified. JG – I'll look into this, so the issue is there is no recognition of 10, 20, 30 years etc. NB – Yes. IP – these medals just sit in



area offices rusting. GL – It depends on what the award is for Ian, National they have to go to Canberra. IS – a problem I have is if an officer goes out of his district, he has no authority. GL – Yes, that is something we need to look into. GL – we have a certain amount of money to reinvest into the RFS. So, what we say we want to do and the money we have to do that is 2 different things. We will do as much as we can with what we have got. IS – this has been the same issues with vehicles. Why aren't we pushing back asking for better quality vehicles. IP – vehicles today aren't lasting as long. We say now they last 20 years but really it should be cut back to 15 years. GL – we shouldn't be asking communities to raise funds to build trucks, stations etc. JG – we have 7 on the schedule right now and we will add more next year. GP – with all the improvements we have had and the money that's been thrown into it, I believe the Rural Fire Service is in more trouble now then we ever have been. JG – why is that? GP – the expectation from the public and there are too many volunteers in the brigade for the wrong reasons. IS – we got offered to have a new station built, but we don't need that. There are brigades out there that need it more than we do. IP – one of the issues we are getting are volunteers not respecting our equipment. IP – thank you very much for coming up.

Justin returned to the meeting at 12.20pm

JG – we can share the engagement schedule, but it changes all the time so don't publish it. GL – we will update you as it changes, there is a lot of interest and we want to talk to as many people as possible. JG – I am happy to come to your monthly meetings when I can. AG – I will also come, add me in on the meeting request. IP – we appreciate you coming up. JG – we have a meeting in emerald on Thursday, we don't know where yet. JC – so how do brigade members know? Brooke – the regions are doing invitations for that area. JG – engagement on IT systems and I think we need some specific working groups to look into this. GL – looking at what systems we need for easier ordering of uniforms etc. Its very clunky at the moment. JC – we passed a resolution about this as it is clunky because brigade members are just ordering it themselves when they should be going through first officer. JC - we passed a resolution last year for them to go through their first officer or secretary. JC – TJ was talking about virtual reality? AG – we are looking at proposal to provide area offices with virtual reality training. JC – it all died in the water; Pikey was supposed to be a part of. JG – I will look into. AG – Can I just flag one of the challenges we have is permit to light system. I believe Qld is the only state that does permit all years around. Do you think it would be worthwhile only having permits in high fire danger times. It would be a relief off the fire wardens. They still need to have fire breaks etc, they will still notify firecom etc. IP – I think we need to stick with what we have. At the moment we know where the fires are that are being lit. I say stick with what with have. IS – the prosecutions are the problem, nothing ever happens. GP – Question, why was summit put on in the middle of school holidays? JG – we really struggled to get venues. AR – I think we need more fire wardens. IP – biggest problem we have is the fire warden finder numbers just rings out. JC – It was identified in the Malone review that a lot of fire wardens and brigades don't speak. Have a look at the Malone recommendation. JG – we asked this question in Townsville and the consensus was not to have them in the brigades.

7.1. IS – The legality of requiring drivers' licence as proof of identification for blue card applications

- a. IS – Blue card application renewal. Driver's licence is not a proof of identity. IP – It is, but you can use something else with a photo on it. Transport department export your photo to



BlueCard. IS – its not a proof identity. IP – I think you would find it is. AR – on the Queensland Government website it says it is.

7.2. IS – National Emergency Medal

- a. IS – had a group meeting and the medals from the floods still haven't been issued and I am being asked what is happening with them. JC – the feds have said there is a hold up with production on there end. I'll get onto Nick and see what we want to do. Difficulty is QFES don't tell the Minister anything. JC – I will send you an email about it swado. IS – the applications went in, but nothing happened. JC – can you go to the brigade who have applied and get them to send me an email so I can follow it up please.

7.3. JC – Possible Receipt Book

- a. JC – if BTSO had one of these books they could write down, who the person was, what the problem was etc, its carbonated so they give the person a receipt of the conversation. That way the BTSO has a list of things they need to do and the inspector can ask to look at the book and make them follow it up. Also, volunteer would have a copy that they can use to follow up if they don't hear anything. Alan didn't like the idea because he said everyone has tablets. Who's ever seen a BTSO with a table write anything down? GP – they don't. JC - It would be a good opportunity and if you like it we should push the fire service to supply them. IS – if you can get them to comply with it, great. JC – what are your thoughts on taking this to volunteers next week and getting feedback? That way the volunteer would get a receipt that you can follow it up. IP – need to get the BTSO out there first. JC – that's Alans job. JC – we will shop this around next week on the SKID tour and see what the volunteer's thoughts are. IP – bring it with you next week.

7.4. JC - Fair work

- a. JC – Michael Corrigan and I had a meeting with fair work today in relation to Stacey Phelps. This was conciliation where the 2 parties try and come to an amicable solution.

7.5. IS – Electric back

- a. IS – I haven't been able to find any designers or producers so far. We need someone with the expertise to draw up a design. You are going to need to 200 amp to run a decent size motor. GP – the only way you can get a lot of pressure is a piston pump or a mono propeller pump. Problem is once they start pumping the water has to go somewhere. JC – pressure release valve. JC – can you 3 meet down with the ford ranger and Kelso as he is the one paying the bills and give him an understanding. IP – when is it being painted? JC – I have to ask TJ. GP – I'll talk to Kelso next week. IS – where is the vehicle? IP – at my place.
