Organisational Structure

The Rural Fire Brigades Association Queensland (RFBAQ) is the recognised body supporting and representing all Queensland's rural fire brigades. We support over 28,000 rural fire brigade volunteers by advocating to State Government and key stakeholders to improve support for brigades, providing RFBAQ grants and support to brigades.

Association Income

The RFBAQ is fully self-funded with no brigade subscription and no Federal, State or Local Government money. Our income is generated by fundraising through our Contact Centre which sells Art Union tickets, takes donations and brigade specific donations. RFBAQ has supplied over \$5m in grants to rural fire brigades in Queensland.

Brigade Specific Donations

The fastest and most efficient way to give money to brigades.

A Brigade Specifc Donation is when someone makes a donation to the RFBAQ and they request for the donation to go to a specific brigade.

We then forward the entire donation to the requested brigade and provide the donor with a tax deductible receipt. The RFBAQ passes on the full amount of the donation and does not in any way deduct an administration fee, so 100% of the donation is forwarded onto the specified brigade.

The RFBAQ can also directly deposit donations into a brigade's bank account, instead of posting them out a cheque.


